Managing Stage Assistant & Stage Runner(s) as well as:

- load in, set-up & breakdown of department
- Check- in all routines once arrived backstage using competition software on iPad
- informing competitors to standby backstage until ready to perform
- facilitating prop & set management
- observe cleanliness of all department spaces i.e.; backstage, dressing rooms, stage
- properly notating any changes to the run of show
- overseeing preparation of awards table
- Expedition of awards during ceremonies
- responsible for all announcements made throughout the weekend
- correctly announce each routine before they take the stage

- generate the appropriate overall reports for each awards ceremony
- oversee/check that awards basket is properly prepared before brought to the stage
- ensure that all competition materials are distributed to the appropriate studios
- direct communication with studio directors at shows end to distribute studio packets
- maintain constant communication with Stage Manager & Sound
- update tabulation site with changes to run of show i.e. scratches, holds
- manage all specialty awards i.e. regional title, studio specials, ADCC, highest scoring studio
